Some of the upcoming activities are the Beach Party on August 29<sup>th</sup>. We should have beaches and this will be the last beach party of the year.






## Steve Snider Says Sail in Windycrest's 36<sup>th</sup> Annual Charity Regatta






# Windycrest Sailing Club 36<sup>th</sup> Annual Charity Regatta
