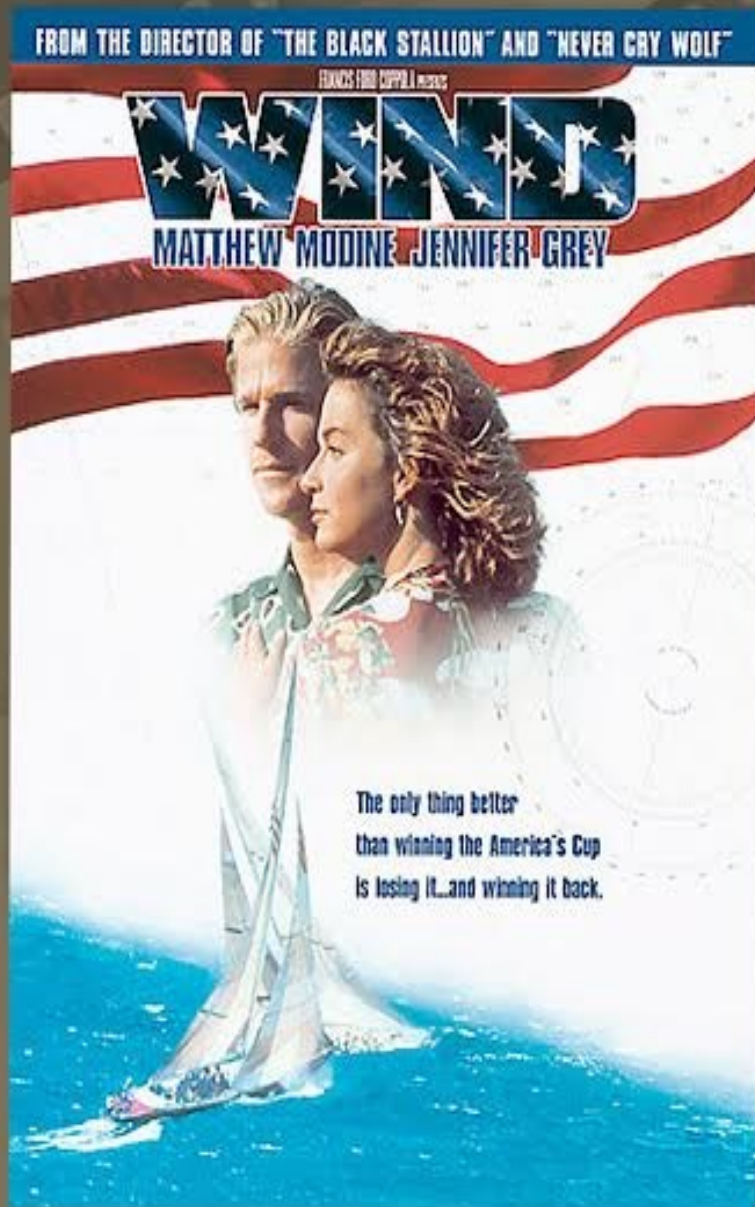

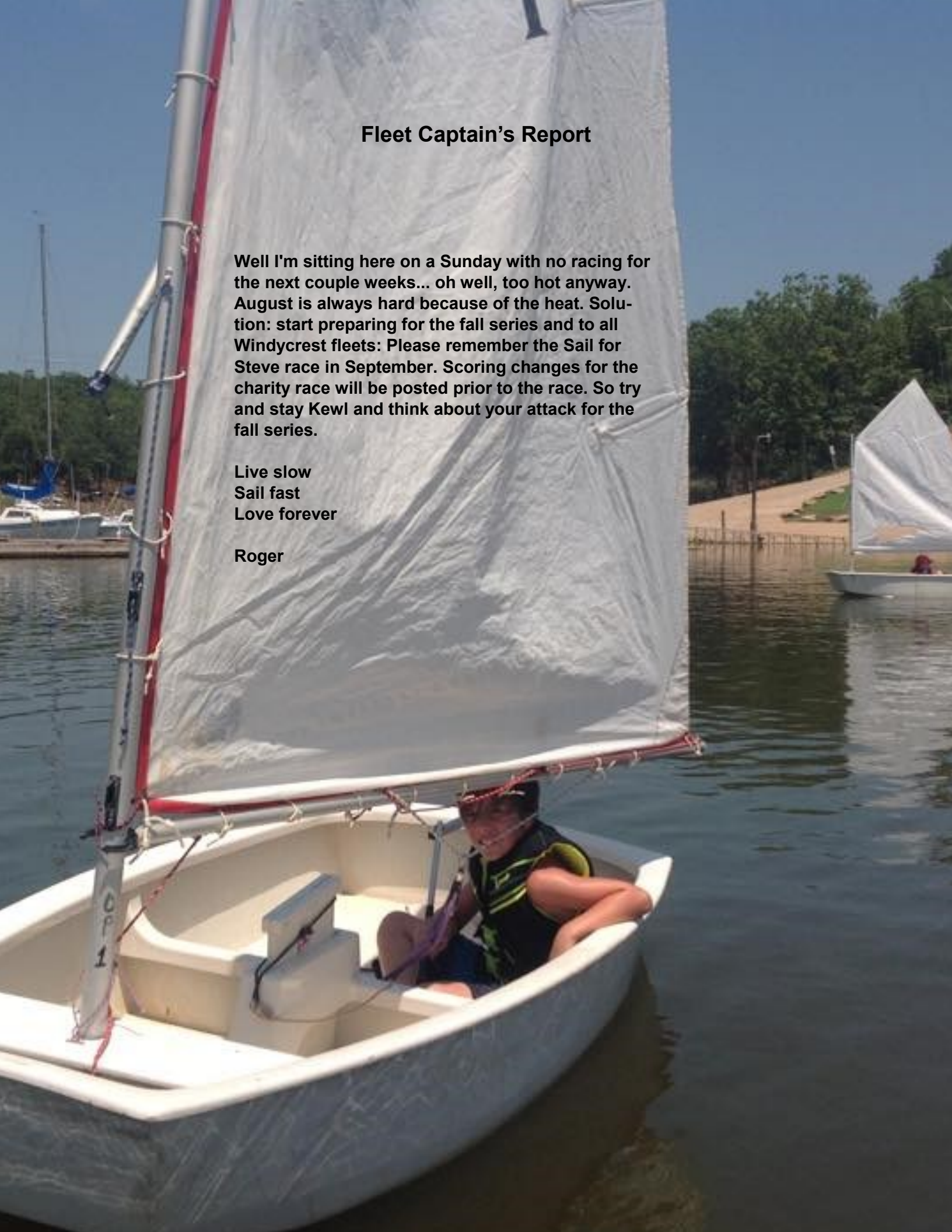


Fleet Captain's Report

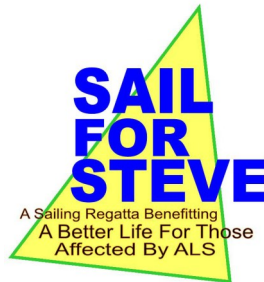

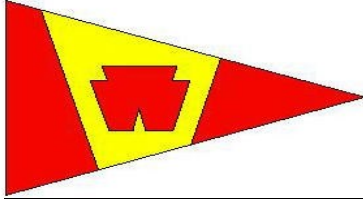
