From the Treasurer

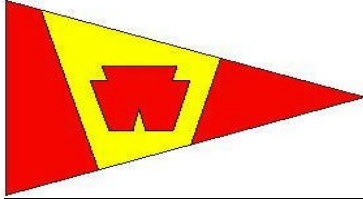

Only 62 to go. **Remember that if your renewal is postmarked after February 15th, you must include the late fee for it to be processed. See your renewal form for details.** If applicable fees are not included, processing will be suspended until full payment is received. Payment in full of all current year dues and fees is required.

If you use a payment service such as "Bill Pay" please note it on your renewal form and remember that the controlling date for renewals is the date that the signed renewal form, complete payment and signed lease (if applicable) are received by us. Legible postmark dates are controlling, if you are mailing close to a deadline, you may want to have your envelope manually cancelled. Bill payment services may take up to 10 days for payment to reach us after you request it.

Please mail your renewal as soon as possible to help the Board of Governors plan for the upcoming sailing season. It would be great if we didn't collect any late fees this year.

The following is a little history on things Bryan has experienced in his time sailing.

- ◆ Started sailing 10 years ago (2005) on Lake Minnetonka when we lived in Excelsior, MN.
- ◆ Started racing in Wales in 2006 crewing aboard a Tripp 40 on the Bristol Channel. I honestly didn't know you could race sailboats at the time (no kidding). There isn't much sailing growing up around farming and ranching in the Dakotas and Montana. But the friendly Welsh invited me along anyhow and I was hooked! Learned that you can sail close-hauled and go backwards in 6-7 knot tidal flows. Became the main sail trimmer on a J/109 at the Cardiff Bay Yacht Club. Became the resident Yank over the next several years during my travels abroad. Also did racing in Denmark and Germany.
- ◆ Bought Maybe (J/24) in Noank, CT, the same town that Chris Gill (former Windycrest member and Hilti guy) is from and mom still lives there. Sailed at both Minnetonka Yacht Club and Wayzata Yacht clubs.
- ◆ Sailed on Jon's J/24 at Wayzata Yacht Club when Jon Crump wasn't able to race and I didn't have crew. I sailed more with his brother, Matt, than Jon.
- ◆ Moved to Tulsa in December 2010 and joined Windycrest. It wasn't until Jon Crump moved to Tulsa about a year later that we started sailing together.

Bought another boat, MC, a few weeks ago and I'm looking forward to doing more racing.
