

Ticket Cost: \$10 per ticket and can be purchased from Steve or Mary Snider or their representative.


The drawing will be September 10, 2016 just before the Skippers Meeting at the 10:30 AM.

We've also been involved with several families in the process of setting up caregiving networks that will provide the crucial additional help to care for their loved ones. 
