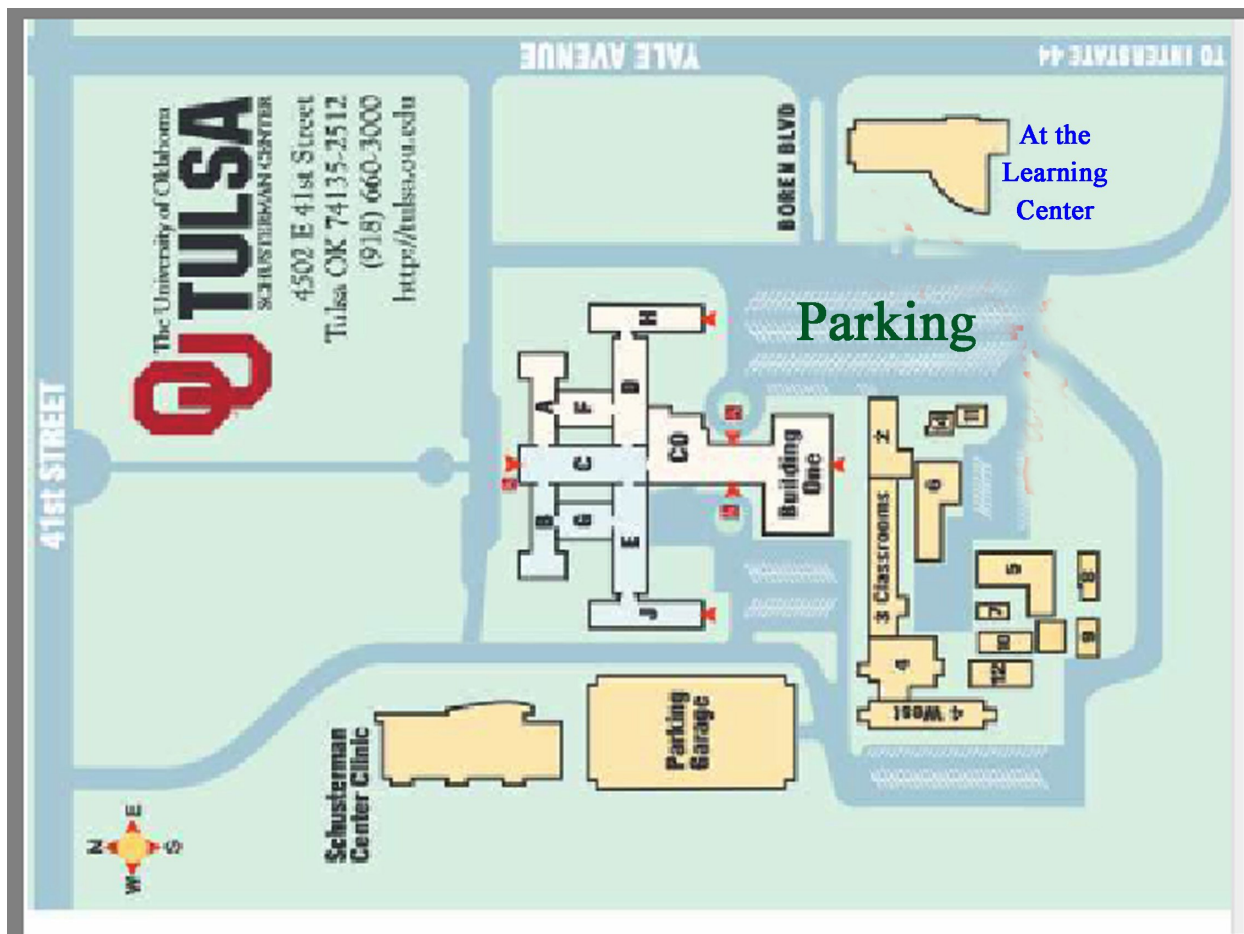

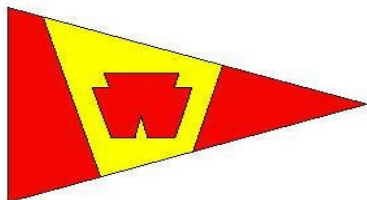

Guests that were present: Kevin Calman (Facilities Manager)

Approval of minutes of last meeting and secretary comments: There were no changes to the last meeting's minutes and they were approved as presented.

Windword editor comment: Julie was absent tonight and the Windword deadline will be on November 15th.

Treasurer report:

Tom was absent but provided his report to IV. Annual lease has been paid.

Tom is requesting board members to send in their estimated budget/expenses for 2017.

There are a couple of abandoned boats for sale. An offer was made and board approved.

Discussion made on possibly repairing Race Committee boat this winter such as flooring of boat needs repair, wires below boat need to be removed and a fire truck horn may be installed.

Vice Commodore report:

Drew is planning the spring projects and he has submitted his budget. Still working on plans for the Breakwater.

We are having to remind people they are responsible for their slips and removing their hydro-hoist when no longer using the slip.

Work Party will be Saturday, May 6. One suggestion for a work party project is to put numbers on the mooring balls.

Facility Manager report:

Kevin added 4th anchor to the Big Breakwater and is working on getting it more parallel to C Dock.

A Doc is being reviewed for instability issues and possibly needs more floatation. Kevin will research floatation options. Drew asked if it will be more work than what can be completed during work party.

Discussed using wood boards on A Doc going forward and eventually replacing some older plastic type boards that are warping and causing potential tripping hazards. We need evaluation of best way to install wood on A Doc to prevent warping.

Activities Captain report:

Harvey and Marsha reported on Christmas Party is Saturday 6:30pm, December 10th. Drew found a band, Creole Gumbo. Invitations are going to printer by November 25 and people will need to RSVP by December 5th.

We are still looking for volunteer to fill this position.
