With a replacement cost of over \$10,000 per slip maximizing their lifespan is a good investment in our future!

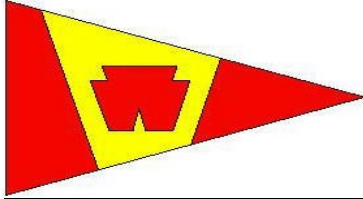
