To signup for a meal, just log into www.lotsahelpinghands.com, pick a date or dates, and sign up. It couldn't be easier.



WSC Board Minutes September 9, 2019

Call Meeting to order: Skeeter Chilton (Commodore), Jason Williams – absent (Vice Commodore), Robbie Corcoran – absent (Rear Commodore), David Hyman (Fleet Captain), Maurice Casad (Secretary), Tom Proctor - absent (Treasurer), Mark Hoagland (Activities Chairman) and Drew Ziegler (Past Commodore)

Guests present:

Michelle Young, potential new member; Carmen Skelton, potential new member; Lisa Weatherholt, member; Bob White, member.

New Member Requests – Michelle Young and Carmen Skelton were both present and are interested in applying for membership at WSC. Michelle Young does not own a boat or have a lot of sailing experience and is interested in an Associate Membership. Carmen Skelton is interested in purchasing the Catalina 22 that was donated to WSC by Donna Rutledge for \$200. She requested to join WSC as a Member.

A motion was made and seconded to accept Carmen Skelton's membership application, and it was approved.

Old Business:

Flood Damage -

The pavilion rock façade needs to be repaired and the work will probably require someone with masonry skills.

The electricity repairs are underway. The lights in the pavilion are not working yet, some of the pavilion receptacles are operable but not all.

The power to all of C dock is still not functioning. Bob White was present at the meeting to request that this be given a priority to repair. Skeeter informed him that the repairs are being prioritized and addressed as quickly as possible with limited resources.

The water lines on B dock are not functioning and there is a water leak at the end of C dock. Members are reminded to please turn on the water when necessary to the docks and then turn off the water supply to the docks when finished

The WSC hydro-hoist that was available for any member to use has been removed. It was damaged by the flood beyond the point of repair. The board will consider whether to replace it.

A new beer tap has been installed in the pavilion to help facilitate lively and candid post sailing discussions.


